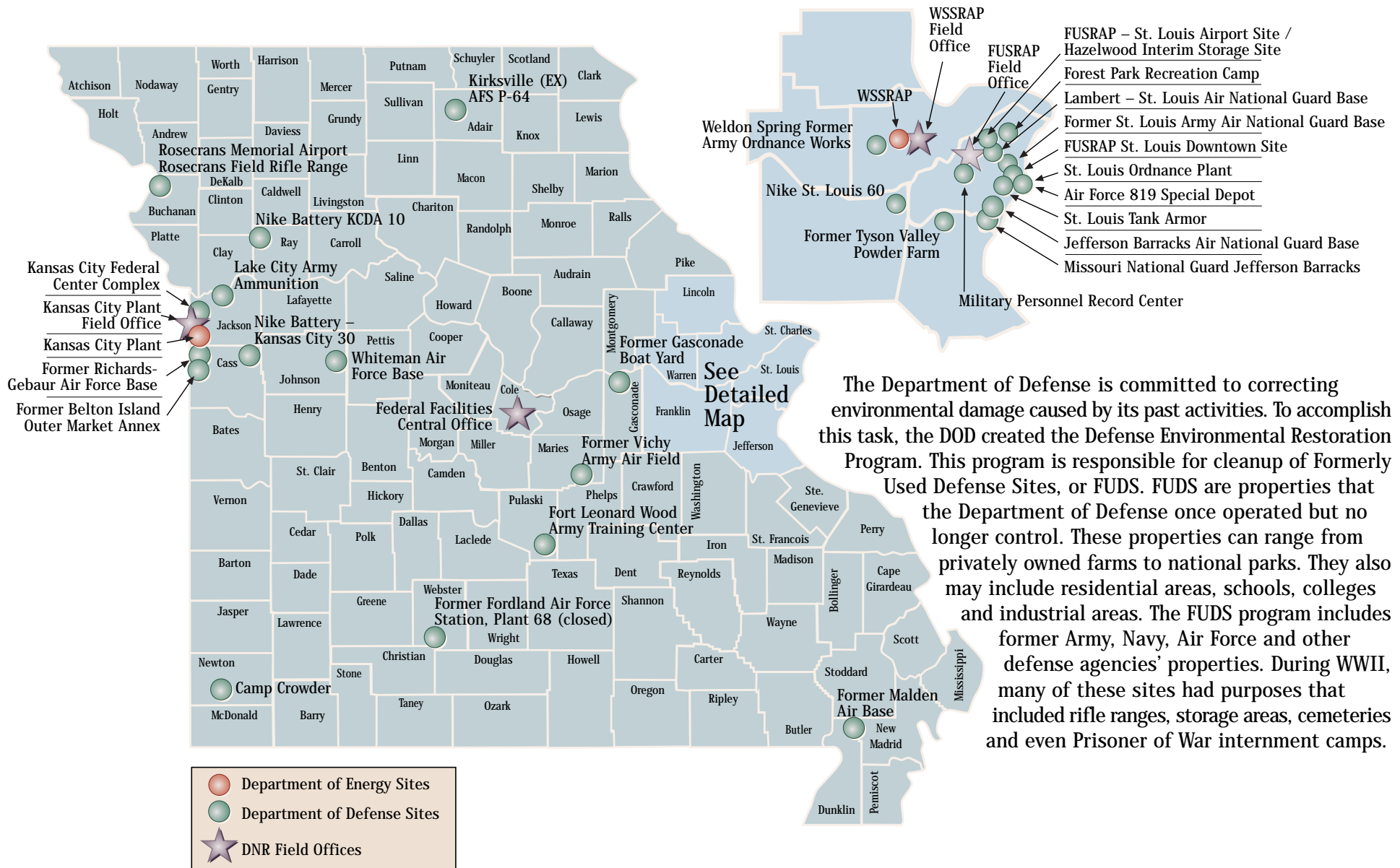
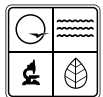


Federal Facility Sites in Missouri



The Department of Defense is committed to correcting environmental damage caused by its past activities. To accomplish this task, the DOD created the Defense Environmental Restoration Program. This program is responsible for cleanup of Formerly Used Defense Sites, or FUDS. FUDS are properties that the Department of Defense once operated but no longer control. These properties can range from privately owned farms to national parks. They also may include residential areas, schools, colleges and industrial areas. The FUDS program includes former Army, Navy, Air Force and other defense agencies' properties. During WWII, many of these sites had purposes that included rifle ranges, storage areas, cemeteries and even Prisoner of War internment camps.
